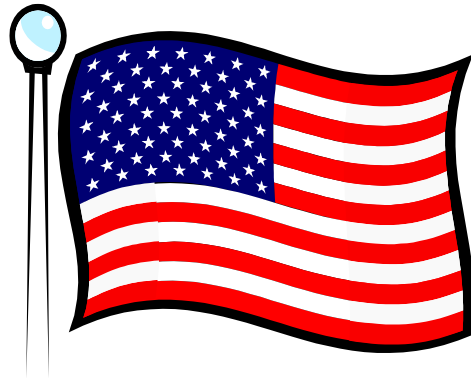

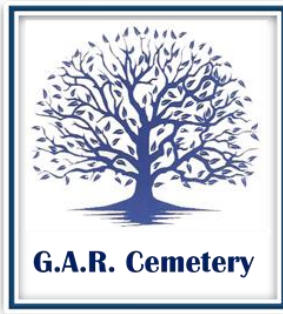

# **G.A.R. CEMETERY**

## **ADOPT-A-FLAG PROGRAM**

**RULE 1:** This program is open to any citizen, civic organization, or business that wishes to Adopt-A-Flag at G.A.R. Cemetery. Ownership of property within G.A.R. Cemetery is not required.

**RULE 2:** The cost to Adopt-A-Flag will be \$50.00. This fee includes a flag, flag pole, and memorial plaque. The memorial plaque will be 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "x2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and will include the following inscription: "In Memory of....." or "In Honor of....." and the name of the individual to be memorialized or honored. Once a flag is purchased, it will become the property of G.A.R. Cemetery.

**RULE 3:** Placement of flags will be at the discretion of the G.A.R. Sexton, and all flags will be displayed on Memorial Day, 4th of July and Veteran's Day. The G.A.R. Sexton reserves the right to add additional holidays at a later date but will never lessen the number of holidays the flags are displayed.

**RULE 4:** It will be the responsibility of the G.A.R. Sexton to ensure the flags are maintained and that proper flag etiquette is always followed.
